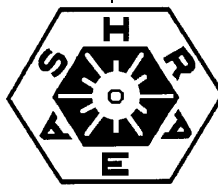

ABOUT THE SPEAKER



Jan Sundell is an environmental scientist, from Sweden, with a unique background in both engineering (M.Sc.Eng) and medicine (Dr.Med.Sc.). Before going into science he was responsible for building codes, and occupational

health legislation in Sweden and the Nordic countries. He was the main author of a model building code for ventilation in homes for UN. He has conducted several large multi-disciplinary studies on associations between indoor environmental factors and health. His efforts have focused on ventilation, the causes of sick building syndrome, and for the increase in allergies/asthma. He has led numerous European multi-disciplinary reviews of the total scientific literature with regard to indoor climate and health.

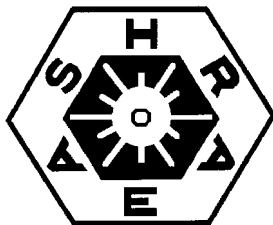
